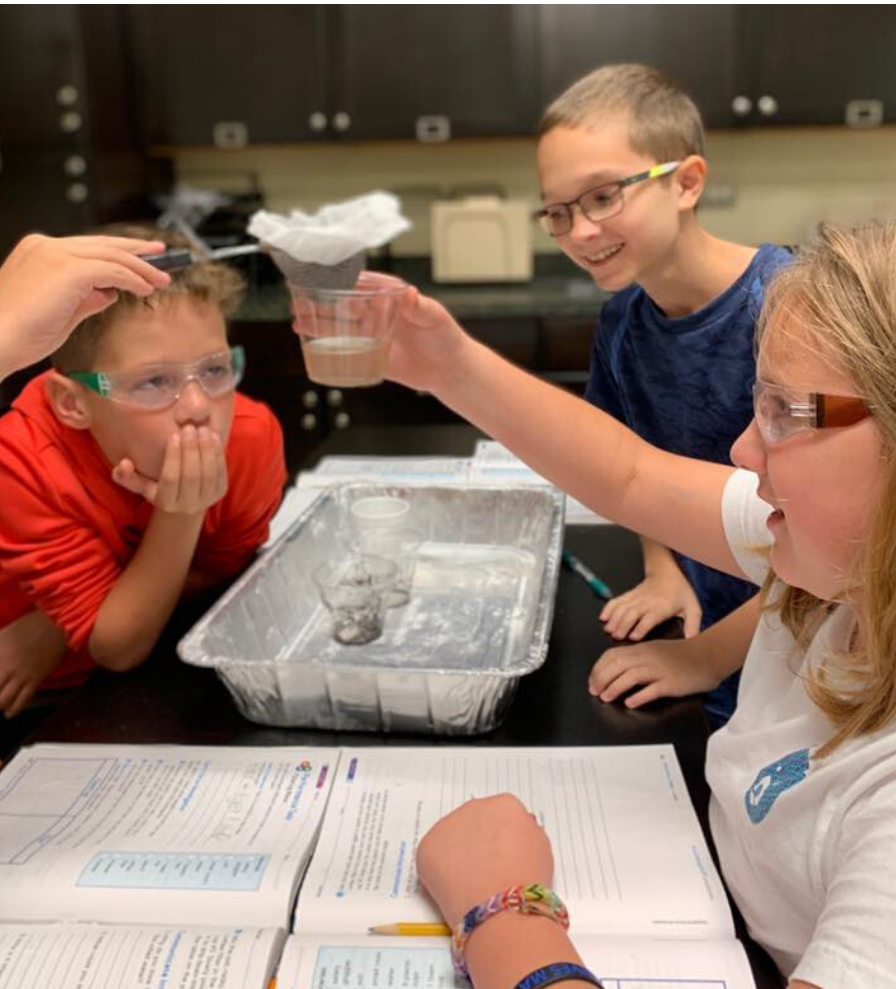


The Roswell North Elementary Foundation annually funds 100% of the costs associated with the Licata Science Lab, the Life Science Extension (Chef's Lab), and the RNE Garden—including the salary of full-time science and garden teacher, Liz Rains.

RNEF also funds programs, improvements, or initiatives consistent with the school's strategic plan. Historically, RNEF has funded playground shade, classroom technology, teacher training, 5th grade field trip scholarships, and more. Last year, RNEF launched a campaign to fund a covered outdoor classroom, which it aims to fully fund during the 2019-2020 school year.

HOW DOES RNEF RAISE MONEY?

The RNE Foundation asks parents to donate during the Fall Campaign and invites them to attend the Spring Soirée and Auction. An increasing number of community business sponsors also offer support.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

Fully funded the Licata Science Lab, Life Science Extension (Chef's Lab), and the RNE Garden including teacher salary and supplies such as:

The RNE Science Lab is one of only two elementary school-level science labs in North Fulton. It is fully funded by your donations to RNEF.

OUTDOOR CLASSROOM



In the 2018/2019 school year, RNEF launched a multi-year campaign to fund a covered outdoor classroom for hands-on learning across all grade levels and concentrations. Students may work with seedlings, dissect specimens, paint landscapes, review math lessons, read books, write stories, or rehearse music — all while cultivating a love for the outdoors.

LAB & GARDEN CURRICULUM

Science and garden teacher Liz Rains works closely with lead teachers from every grade level to plan experiments that align with classroom curriculum.

Kindergarten: buoyancy, local rocks, pollination, snow, constellations and Earth's movement

1st: create rain clouds, magnets, light and sound, build model of human ear, square foot gardening

2nd: force and motion, witness liquid to solid while making butter, make crystals, dissect worms

3rd: classify rocks, local cartography, bird beak adaptations, water pollution, dissect owl pellets

4th: create water filtration systems, build a StarLab, force and motion egg project, dissect frogs

5th: build paper circuits and flashlights, chemical change, create microslides, dissect tiger sharks

The **Monarchs Across Georgia** program will allow students to witness the metamorphosis and migration of butterflies.

School-wide taste tests through the **Oh My Squash!** Georgia Organics Farm to School Program.

All students will visit the 4th grade's homemade **StarLab** to study constellations and Earth rotations.
